

ASCP Policy on Equity, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI)

According to the ASCP Constitution, "The Society also actively supports principles of equity, diversity and inclusion" (§3.1).

The ASCP

- is committed to the principles of equity, diversity, and social inclusion
- rejects discrimination on the basis of race, class, sex, gender identity, disability, sexual orientation, age or any other forms of social disadvantage
- supports a pro-active approach to the advancement of underrepresented and minority communities and their viewpoints
- holds that academic freedom and the protection of the right to equity and diversity are compatible aims

The EDI officer in the ASCP executive is responsible to:

- Develop and implement an action plan for EDI
- · Consult with members about EDI issues
- Assist in the organizing of one or more panels at the annual ASCP conference that address EDI issues from both academic perspectives and for the practical issues facing the Society.
